



ARNOLD M. FEINGOLD PRIZE

(Outstanding Introduction to AST Students)

Arnold Feingold, born in Brooklyn in 1920, has had a lifelong interest as an amateur astronomer. He attended Brooklyn College before going to study Astronomy at Harvard in 1940, taking a leave during World War II. Rather than return to Harvard, he went to Princeton where he did his doctoral research in nuclear physics with Professor Eugene Wigner. He then went to the University of Pennsylvania, Illinois and Utah before coming to our University in 1960 as one of its founding members. He was the first dean of the graduate school and set in place initial aspects of all of the department's programs. Arnold was always available to answer questions, both the easy and the difficult kind. But, he took an especial interest in astronomy questions whether they involved the planets, stars or origin of the solar system.
